The OC Food Bank, a program of Community Action Partnership of Orange County (CAPOC), has evolved into Orange County's most comprehensive hunger-relief organization. Our aim is to make a positive impact in people's lives by helping them meet basic needs and strengthen their support system. The OC Food Bank serves children, families, seniors, veterans, and disabled individuals. We have a stake in the health of our community and the ability to create real change in the lives of our neighbors. In 2013, CAPOC distributed more than 18 million pounds of food to Orange County residents. In addition to direct support, the OC Food Bank supplies 400 local charities with food. Our Food Bank mobilizes and directs resources to programs that assist, educate, and promote self-sufficiency.

In the last decade, the number of children living in poverty has increased by nearly 20%
